1. Appreciation for the Hispanic culture will be strongly considered in the awarding process.
2. Applicants must have at least a 2.5 grade point average (GPA) to qualify.
3. A student's financial need will be a consideration in the selection of recipients.
4. The scholarship will be awarded for the spring 2005 semester only. Recipients can re-apply for renewal each year.
5. **Scholarship recipients should be advised that they are expected to attend at least one Hispanic American Foundation function during the year, in order to be recognized as a scholarship winner. Failure to do so will jeopardize future awards.**
6. Eligible applicants must be enrolled in a University of Oklahoma academic program for the Fall 2004 semester.
